### Design & Space Planning Updates

- Alison Weigley is coordinating project update presentations with each department/clinic. Presentations are co-presented by department directors and Matt.
- Carrie Coen is leading a “Standards Committee” to develop standardized considerations for the Expansion project including Physical Plant, Environment/Regulatory Readiness, Infection Prevention, Environmental Services, Aesthetics and IT.
- Jeannie Eylar is leading “Functional Space Team” workshops with employees and architects including the following departments/areas: BirthPlace, MSU/ICU/rehab, Procedural, Central Sterile Processing, Universal Care Unit, Emergency Department, Laboratory, Imaging/RT, Registration and public spaces, gift shop.
