Operations

- November 11 Contractor will place barriers in the hospital for Phase 1

Budget

- Managing requests outside the scope of the project through our CAPEX process:
 - Some costs, like signs, and patient privacy curtains are outside of what is including in our construction budget for FFE (furniture, fixtures and equipment); our process to purchase those needed items will be through our CAPEX process
