

## **BirthPlace Visitation:**

- Visitors will be screened prior to admittance to the hospital and must be without symptoms
  of cough, fever, body aches, or respiratory symptoms. Wearing a mask is still a requirement.
- A Healthy patient's visitors:
  - o Maximum of 2 visitors/support person(s) at a time.
  - The primary support person:
    - o Primary support person can stay 24/7.
    - BP bands and meals provided for primary support person only.
    - Encouraged to stay, but if he/she leaves, we request limiting exposure to others if planning to return.
  - Back up support person/visitor:
    - A backup support person can stay outside of visiting hours until the patient has delivered and recovered.
    - After delivery visitors can alternate visiting the patient during regular visiting hours. Visitors will be given a visitor badge. (Max 2 support person(s)/visitors at a time)
- A patient that is symptomatic, under investigation or Covid positive is allowed one visitor for the entire stay (who must remain in the room at all times).
- No visitors under 12 (siblings included).

## **BirthPlace Masking:**

 Masks are required to be worn anytime a patient or support person is outside their assigned room or when a health care worker is in the room.
