




January 30, 2026 Update

Construction & Wayfinding Updates

- Ceiling work just outside of the Surgery Lounge will block hallway access, starting **Mon. Feb 2nd extending for 1 to 1.5 weeks.**
 - Note blue box in map below.
- Impact to traffic patterns for everyone who uses the key coded door by the surgery dressing rooms to access the OR or Same Day North.
- Impact to how we respond to codes and rapid response in the OR and Same Day North.
- And, this will impact how all staff (anesthesia, materials, lab, pharmacy, red sage, evs, respiratory, imaging and more) access Same Day North and the OR.
- To access the OR and Same Day North:
 - Use the key coded/prox door via surgery patient waiting room
 - Applies to everyone (staff, vendors, surgeons, etc)
 - Note change for rapid response and codes
 - In effect Mon Feb 2 for 1 to 1.5 weeks
- To access the surgery dressing rooms, pathology and offices (including anesthesia):
 - Still accessible through the key coded door at the locker room hallway entrance
 - The rest of the department can be accessed through SDS north door
 - The door for Same Day North (near the patient waiting area) is accessible by code or prox badge access



Construction & Wayfinding Updates

OR/Same Day North Continued:

- This will also mean the surgery lounge is not accessible.
- Construction has minimized traffic in the BirthPlace hallway, creating a quiet space for meal and rest breaks with benches and chairs available.
- Communication Plan for this traffic pattern change:
 - Dusty: Surgeons, Clinics and ENT
 - Steve: OR/CS staff
 - Anna/Sarah: Same Day/PACU staff
 - Stephanie & Dr. Mikkelsen: Emergency physicians & staff, EMS & CCs
 - Hannah: OB/GYNs, OB primary care, & pediatricians
 - Dave: Anesthesia/Interventional Pain Mgmt.
 - Verna: Hospitalists & Code/Rapid Response Teams
 - Alison: Planning stakeholders & leadership & “all” communications
 - Amber: OR signage

OR:

- Concurrently, work in the OR hallway in front of ORs 1-4 with the mobile HEPA carts will be performed Feb 4 starting at 1800 to 0600 Feb 5. these carts are mobile and will not block traffic flow.

Emergency Entrance & Exit:

- Normal traffic patterns using the Emergency Department patient and staff entrance/exit have resumed ahead of schedule. This entrance/exit is now open! Welcoming signage will be added to help with wayfinding.



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
PULLMAN REGIONAL HOSPITAL - PATIENT CARE EXPANSION




Exterior scaffolding is being wrapped with plastic sheeting in preparation for temporary heating provisions.



Trench pour backs are ongoing in the Palouse phase of work, following recent completion of underground plumbing.




Slab on grade demolition continues in the Palouse phase of work, supporting upcoming underground plumbing.




Backing and in-wall MEP rough-in progresses in the Lewiston phase of work.
